To respond to the needs of the growing Grayslake area and through a generous donation by Esper A. Peterson, the Grayslake Outdoor Aquatic Center was constructed. The project scope for the approximately 7-acre site included the design of site improvements including:

- Access Drives
- Parking Lots
- Underground Utility Infrastructure
- Stormwater Detention
- Watermain Extension & Service to Bathhouse & Pool

The wet-bottom stormwater detention basin was designed using Lake County Stormwater ordinance standards.

Planning was also provided for future athletic fields and a civic center.
